JOB GOAL: To instruct athletes in the fundamental skills, strategies, and physical conditioning necessary for them to realize a degree of success and promote good sportsmanship and good mental health.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Establishes the fundamental philosophy, skills and techniques of the assigned sport to be taught.
2. Provides the students with an atmosphere in which each person is treated with respect and the opportunity to learn and develop skills.
3. Provides the expression of professional attributes, good sportsmanship, and serves as a positive role model for the students.
4. Gives constant attention to the student athletes' grades and conduct.
5. Maintains full responsibility for the overall supervision of the program.
6. Maintains a complete inventory of equipment used for the sport and assumes responsibility for the general upkeep and protection of that equipment.
7. Submits all required end-of-season reports/data to the Athletic Director.

WORK YEAR: Active sports season. Salary and benefits to be established by the School Committee.

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of the School Committee's policy on evaluation.
