The Special Meeting of the Gorham School Committee was called to order at 6:04 PM by Chairman Wright and the roll was called.

Mr. Libby moved, seconded by Ms. Nelson to go into executive session at 6:05 PM to consider the expulsion of a high school student pursuant to M.R.S.A. Section 405(6)(B). The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.

Ms. Phillips moved, seconded by Ms. Nelson to come out of executive session at 6:56 PM. The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.

Mr. Libby moved, seconded by Ms. Phillips to permit a student to return to school conditioned upon the student's and family's full participation in the plan recommended by the administration, provided that, upon violation of the plan, the student shall be returned to the School Committee for further disciplinary action up to and including expulsion. The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.

Mr. Libby moved, seconded by Mr. Burns to approve the 2016-2017 PATHS vocational assessment of \$112,196.00. The motion passed 6 YES, 0 NO.

Craig Larrabee, President and Dwight Littlefield, VP of Operations gave a presentation on the *Jobs for Maine's Graduates* program.

Kathy Hamblen, Director of Special Services, gave an overview on the closing of the SEA school and its impact on the Gorham schools.

Norm Justice, Director of Facilities & Transportation, reviewed the Gorham School Department's emergency plan.
