The Special Meeting of the Gorham School Committee was called to order by Chairman Wright at 6:07 PM and the roll was called.

Mr. Burns moved, seconded by Ms. Nelson to go into executive session at 6:07 PM to consider the expulsion of a Gorham High School student pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. Section 405(6)(B). The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.

Ms. Nelson moved, seconded by Mr. Libby to come out of executive session at 9:00 PM. The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.

Mr. Libby moved, seconded by Mr. Burns that:

- a. The student under consideration has been deliberately disobedient;
- b. The student was actively involved in knowingly possessing drugs and drug paraphernalia while on school property in violation of school policies;
- c. As discipline, the student be expelled from school indefinitely pursuant to 21-A MRSA, Section 1001(9) on the grounds that the expulsion is necessary for the peace and usefulness of the schools;
- d. The Superintendent give the student and the student's parents/guardians written notice of the School Committee's findings and conclusions; and
- e. I further move that the Superintendent and his/her designee develop a written reentry plan for the student under consideration specifying the conditions for readmission to school.

The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.

Mr. Libby moved, seconded by Mr. Burns to approve the 2016-2017 Great Schools Partnership contract as presented. The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.

Mr. Burns moved, seconded by Ms. Nelson to adopt the Evaluation of Professional Staff Members Policy (GCO) as presented. The motion passed 5 YES, 0 NO.
