Laptop Protection Plan 2015-2016

Students note: You will be quizzed on the information below. Be sure you read this from before you sign it!

The Gorham School Department issues a laptop to every student in grades 6-12. We recognize that even when exercising the greatest care, accidents happen. When those accidents involve a device that costs \$1,000, the repairs can be costly.

As it was last year, the laptop protection plan is required for the 2015-2016 school year. The cost is \$25 for all students. Accident claims will be handled differently this year. For the 2015-2016 school year, a \$50 deductible per claim/incident will be charged. This deductible will also be charged when damage is found on laptops that are collected at the end of the school year.

NOTE: Intentionally damaged computers or computers damaged due to neglect or vandalism will not be covered by this plan. The application of adhesive decals or the permanent alteration of the physical appearance of the laptop in any way will be considered vandalism.

Note: The administration reserves the right to bill students for the entire repair cost for damage deemed to be intentional or due to neglect, or for damage to multiple laptops during the year.

Filing a claim

- Notify the school Administration or the technology department
• Complete a narrative describing the damage and the cause
• Return a claim form with a parent signature.

Note: A laptop will NOT be issued until this form is signed and returned with a check made out to The Gorham School Department for \$25.
